

***EnviroLogic Resources, Inc., to Implement Water Quality Monitoring  
under OGCSA and WWGCSA Stewardship Guidelines***

Currently, approximately 20 golf courses in Oregon and Washington conduct their operations in accordance with the *Guidelines*.
