The Feasibility Study will address those areas where unacceptable risks have been identified in the risk assessments and will likely be conducted on an AOC-by-AOC basis by subgroups of the Astoria Area-Wide Cooperating Parties. A specific plan of action for the Feasibility Study will be provided to DEQ.
